SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

following principles:

1. WORKPLACE SAFETY

We take the necessary safety precautions in our workplaces to ensure the safety of our employees and guests. We organize continuous training and drills on emergency exits, fire safety, emergency equipment, etc.

2. SAFETY TRAININGS

We use safe materials in the construction and maintenance of our hotel. We conduct regular inspections and make necessary updates on building safety and structural durability.

4. HOTEL SECURITY SYSTEM

The Komana ensures security throughout the facility by using security systems effectively. We constantly monitor and update systems such as camera systems, closed circuit televisions and entrance and exit controls.

5. CUSTOMER SAFETY

We keep the safety of our guests at the highest level. We increase security measures in and around the hotel and offer our guests a safe accommodation experience.

6. EMERGENCY PLANS

The Komana ensures the safe evacuation of employees and guests by creating



emergency plans. We aim for fast and effective response in case of emergency.
