



# Code of Conduct for Natural and Wildlife Areas

## SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

At The Komana, we encourage our guests to act respectfully and sustainably when visiting natural and protected areas. The following behavior guidelines should be followed to help preserve these valuable ecosystems:

### 1. Respect Local Regulations

- Follow the local conservation rules of the area you are visiting.
- Stay on designated roads, trails, and marked areas.

### 2. Waste Management

- Collect all waste and dispose of it in appropriate recycling bins.
- When picnicking, choose recyclable and environmentally friendly materials.

### 3. Respect for Plants and Animals

- Avoid picking wild plants and be careful not to disturb wildlife.
- Stay on designated paths, especially in sensitive ecosystems.

### 4. Noise Control

- Speak in low voices in natural areas to maintain a peaceful environment.
- When using music or other audio devices, be mindful of the surroundings and other visitors.

### 5. Camping and Fire Rules

- Speak in low voices in natural areas to maintain a peaceful environment.

### 6. Camping and Fire Rules

- Do not interfere with animals' natural behaviors during observation.
- Be careful not to damage the habitats of plants and animals while taking photographs.

### 7. Use of Natural Resources

- Limit water usage to support the conservation of natural resources.



- Be aware of and respect the limitations on collecting natural materials and comply with local regulations.
